

TCYSA Announces Coaching Assignments; Chris Brewer Rejoins Twins Coaching Staff

Chris Brewer, a veteran youth-soccer coach who worked as Director of Coaching for TCYSA from 1997 to 2003, is one of three new staff coaches added to the Twins coaching line-up for the 2009-10 season.

Brewer, who most recently worked as a director of coaching for the Greensboro Youth Soccer Association, will be coaching the 98 Lady Twins Blue and the 98 Twins Blue teams. Along with his coaching assignments, Chris will join the TCYSA staff as a Technical Director as well as continue as a Staff Coach and a U.S. National Academy Coach for the United States Soccer Federation.

She will be coaching the 93 Lady Twins Silver. Travis will be coaching the 97 Twins Silver, the 95 Twins Blue and the 94 Twins Blue teams. Travis is an assistant coach with the Men Soccer's Program at Wake Forest University.

Again, we have managed to add three highly qualified youth coaches that will allow us to continue to build the foundation of strong coaches we have working with our players."
