Complex Rules and Regulations:

Please:

- **No pets** (except little brothers and sisters)
- **No smoking** on the premises (please help remind our visitors)
- **No alcohol, drugs or firearms permitted on premises.**
- **No convicted sex offenders allowed on premises.**
- **No glass containers.**
- **Please follow all posted speed limit signs.**
- **All minors must be under adult supervision at all times.** Parents should keep children away from pond and river areas.
- **Mind your mouth** (Foul or abusive language is not attractive, and thus will not be tolerated)
- **Pick up after yourself** (and others). One piece of trash will promote the next. Please refrain from littering and go one step further by picking up after each other.
- **Respect the decisions of the committee** to protect your fields/facility.
- **Treat these fields and facilities with the respect.** They are in fact yours.
- **Do not move or otherwise relocate the goals.** With the exception of the Corver, stand-up training goals, all goals will be placed prior to training or games by the facility manager to minimize wear and tear of the field playing surfaces. Please train in a location and in a manner so as to minimize damage to the playing field. Warming up or training in the mouth of the goals will not be allowed. Goals are to be used only when properly anchored.
- **Use these fields only when properly authorized to do so.** Please consult the TCYSA Website at www.twincitysoccer.com to review the current field schedule or to make inquiries with regards to field usage. Please note that due to the TCYSA demand for field usage, our fields are currently not for rent.
- **Understand that only authorized personnel are allowed to operate any of the facility systems** (i.e. lights, irrigation system, etc.)
- **Keep all vehicles off any grass surfaces** (other than emergency or field maintenance vehicles).
- **Report any suspicious or inappropriate behavior.** (You are our eyes and ears.)
- **Strictly follow the Inclement Weather and Lightning Policy.** Our lightning policy at the new complex is the same as it is at all of the facilities we use, and it is spelled out in detail on our web site in the Weather section. In summary, practice or a game will be delayed a minimum of 30 minutes if a flash of lightning and its thunderclap occur within 30 seconds or less of one another. Practice or a game will not resume until 30 minutes after the last sound of thunder. Players are required to leave the field and should get in a vehicle during the thunder break. When the Field house is open, players may go into the Field house. Please see the www.twincitysoccer.com website for the full TCYSA Inclement Weather and Lightning Policy.

TCYSA SOCCER COMPLEX FIELD USE POLICY

- TCYSA Soccer Complex to be used primarily as a soccer training and game field facility.
- At the discretion of the facilities committee, TCYSA Soccer Complex may accommodate make up games when field conditions allow.
- Beginning Spring 2007, U13 thru U18 Classic and Challenge Teams will each be allowed to schedule one game per season at the TCYSA Complex.
- Due to budget constraints (funds for small sized goals) and limited fields open for play, small sided games will not be played at the complex in the spring of 2007.
- Due to current demand on field usage there will be no field rental at this time. Further, scrimmages between training teams will be limited to those times when the two teams share the same training session time. There will be no outside training session scrimmages for spring 2007.
- Night time games will not be allowed until additional lighting, sufficient for night time play, has been installed.
- Beginning in spring of 2007, training will be limited to two teams per field per training session. There will be two training sessions/evening: 5:30pm – 7:00pm and 7:00pm – 8:30pm, Monday thru Friday.
- All field assignments for training will be made by the DOC/ADOC on a session by session basis each evening. These assignments will be based upon field conditions, number and age of teams, etc.
- Field usage for private training sessions is prohibited. Private sessions (including camps) conducted by the TCYSA coaching staff will be allowed provided it directly benefits the players in the club.
- A total of three game time slots will be allowed (Saturday at 10am, 12 noon and 2pm). Two make-up game time slots will be allowed (Sunday at 2pm and 4pm).
- Any requests for exceptions to the field usage policy set above must be made in writing to the TCYSA Facilities Committee.
- The TCYSA Website will hold a “read only” schedule of all practices and games. A procedure for scheduling will also be posted.
