PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

As a proud parent of a player in the Twin City Youth Soccer Association, I agree to the following:

- I must always remember my child plays soccer for his or her benefit, not mine.
- I will not coach or instruct the players; that is the coach's role.
- I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning so that my child will not be defeated by the result of a game.
- I will offer praise to my child for playing his or her best regardless of the outcome.
- I will listen at all times when my child wishes to discuss issues regarding his or her individual performance.
- I will not argue with or complain about a referee's call or decision, even if the referee makes a mistake.
- I will encourage my child to abide by the rules of the game and maintain a high level of sportsmanship.
- I will support the decisions our coaches make and in doing so support the team.
- I will always remember that children learn best by examples that are set for them.
- I will make sure that my child arrives on time for all games, practices and any other soccer functions according to the times set by the coaching staff.
- I will focus on my child's development rather than just winning soccer games.
- I will inform the coach of any injury or illness that may negatively affect the safety of my child or his or her teammates
- To resolve troublesome issues, I will not interrupt a coach immediately prior to, during or after a training session or game. I will discuss these issues privately and discreetly at an appointed time agreed upon with the coach. If this does not result in a satisfactory outcome, I will contact the Director of Coaching.
- I will not discuss issues concerning my child or other players with other parents.
- I will pay my assessments and other team-related fees to the team's treasurer or the Association on time. I understand that failing to do so may result in making my child ineligible to participate in all TCYSA-related events, and may prevent my child from taking part in any program offered by NCYSA or any other of its member associations.
- I will work with my child's team manager to ensure that all administrative tasks requested of my child and me are handled in a timely manner.
- Mine and my child's commitment to his or her team and to TCYSA is for the duration of the 2007-08 soccer season.

By signing this code of conduct, as a Twin City Youth Soccer Association Parent I agree to conduct myself in a positive manner at all times, to respect the game and support the club, the players and the coaches, and to promote the growth of my child athletically, emotionally and physically. I understand that refusal to abide by this Code could result in disciplinary action by our Club and/or NCYSA.
